

TMPF Point Scores – an explanation

In the 'core' subjects of English Reading, English Writing and Maths, you will notice on your child's termly report, a number listed next to the attainment box. Following the abolition of levels by the Department for Education, The Moorlands Primary Federation devised its own assessment system. This system uses a point score, with the expectation that the 'average child' will make one point progress per term: equating to three points per academic year.

At the end of the school year, pupils in Reception, Year 2 and Year 6, will also be assessed against national scales. Children in these year groups will, therefore, also receive additional data based upon statutory end of Key Stage assessments. Further information is available from the respective class teachers.

The tables below are a guide to illustrate how the TMPF Point Scores operates with the year group at the top and the range of the expected points score below. TMPF Point Scores are reviewed and updated at the end of each term.
