# Comic Relief/Kenya Day


Today we have enjoyed celebrating Comic Relief through our Kenya Day. Many thanks for non-uniform donations which raised a total of £53.00.

Black shoes, grey trousers or knee length shorts, white shirt, tie and jumper.

#### Girls

Black shoes, grey skirt, pinafore, school trousers, white shirt, tie and cardigan or jumper

#### PΕ

White polo shirt, black shorts, tracksuit trousers/ leggings, black PE pumps or trainers.

#### General

Coats should be brought every day due to the unpredictable weather.

Hair – shoulder length or longer must be tied back with a bobble, headband should be plain.

Nail vanish should not be worn.
