He lives with his mum and his grandmother who are very poor and cannot afford to pay the fee. His headteacher also tells us: "Morris is very hard working, always leading the class, a good boy, active and playful."

Swabrina

Swabrina is eight and her family have no source of income and so they struggle to eat food regularly. She walks a mile and a half to school every day. Much of her food comes from the porridge she receives at school, so by funding her schooling, we are also helping her to be able to eat. Her headteacher says: "She is responsible, friendly, humble and respectful."

Morris and Swabrina have both written beautiful letters (using lovely handwriting!) which we have shared with the children and we are humbled to see that they are both so happy to receive our gift and they both send us the blessings of God.

We will, of course, keep you updated with any news from our new school-mates in Kenya and know that you will join us in sending love and prayers to them.
