On Wednesday 5th February, Year 6 went to The Cheadle Academy for a transition day. During the day, we did lots of fun activities and the experience enabled us to get to know TCA a little bit better. We did an English activity based on onomatopoeia (which is words that are sounds) and we even got to decorate ginger bread men. Overall, we had a truly great time and cannot wait to be invited back!

#### Moving forward at Bishop Rawle

Over the past few months we have invested heavily in new learning resources for your children. Hopefully you will have already seen and used the new reading scheme books? The children tell us they love the stories and appreciate having new, shiny and nice smelling books! With new phonics books in Key Stage One, we have spent £3000 in this area. The children are also using an online reading, spelling and grammar program named Lexia. So far, they are enjoying their near daily access to this amazing resource. In the ICT suite, wearing their headphones, it resembles a call-centre! However, the children are clearly very engaged as when using the room is totally silent! Although expensive at nearly £2000 per year, early indications are Lexia is a worthwhile investment.

The children have also used a new Maths scheme from September. The Busy Ants maths programme has improved the diversity of the maths the children learn. Again, an expensive resource at over £1000, we believe the children deserve the best and are enjoying undertaking an exciting varied maths curriculum.

In 2020, technology is a fundamental part of our lives. We teach computing and E-Safety as part of our curriculum, and as such need the latest devices to facilitate this teaching. So, we have invested £3000 in new laptops for the children to use and a touchscreen. Thanks to our amazingly generous PTA and your continued support, we are also acquiring new iPads to compliment the ones we have already in school.
