Dear parent/ carer,

We hope that you and the whole family are all doing ok.

In the light of more recent and new Government updates regarding the need to reduce gatherings of larger numbers of people, and our desire to continually reduce risk to our pupils and families, we are slightly amending next week's arrangements for schooling for children whose parents are classed as 'Key Workers'.

Our staff team will still be providing support for the parents of 'Key Workers' who absolutely require school, to enable them to continue their essential work. However, this will not now take place at our sister school of Bishop Rawle C.E. (A) Primary, but will instead still be here at St. Werburgh's.

As developments, circumstance, and advice changes, then we are sure that you understand that our provision of care may change again – which could then lead to a change of site, or for limited hours. We will continue to communicate with you through email and the website.

The Government advice is that the safest thing is to keep your child at home and away from others – 'Social Distancing'. Therefore, please only make use of this school care service if you absolutely have to. Please be aware that the school structure and classes will not be the same as usual due to the circumstances which we face as a school and as a nation. This is simply to keep you child, your family, our staff and our staff's families safe.

Please can we also ensure that if children are being kept at home, then they should remain at home and not visit school, or be out socialising with any others.

The children of Government-identified 'Key Workers' who have already told us that your children will remain in school, should therefore come to St. Werburgh's at 8.45am as usual, and for this week, may still wear appropriate and practical non-uniform clothing and bring PE/Games kit. Again, please can children bring their own snack for break-time and a bottle of water, as fruit and milk services have been discontinued by the providers.

**\*\*\*Please can children in need of medication ensure that this is again brought into school on Monday.**
