Hoping that you are all having a safe and well Easter break, we wanted to keep you informed and up to date with how our 'Home School Learning' will be set, where to access it, and when.

Our 'Home School Learning' challenges will start on <u>Monday 20th April 2020</u>. As a Trust, we have decided that each week, three pieces of English work, three pieces of Maths work and activities in two foundation subjects will be set for the children to complete. This will be alongside the daily 20 minutes of Lexia or home reading that we are also asking your child to complete and multiplication facts practice through TT rockstars.

From here navigate to the Bishop Rawle header.

Once on the Bishop Rawle page, scroll across the headers until you reach 'Our Learning' and from here chose the class option that your child is in, e.g. Indigo Class, Year 4/5











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In each class option there is an email address.



Your child's 'Home School Learning' will be set here every Monday and answers for the work, if appropriate, will be uploaded the following Friday.

Each week an overview of the 'Home School Learning' challenges will available for you to view, allowing you to know the whole weeks work in one place. This will also explain if the work needs to be completed in the red exercise book (issued to your child), or in a document to be emailed back for the teacher to respond. Photographs/images can also be emailed to the teacher using this email address.

Deadlines for any work that needs to be completed and emailed back will be issued when the work is set.

The work set for Maths and English will be set in using bronze, silver and gold challenges, the level of difficulty increases on each level. Your child can do all 3 levels if they wish, or just the one appropriate for their interest and level.

As you will realise, this is a new way for you and us working, and we hope that we won't have too many teething problems.
