Re: Class Three Autumn Term Curriculum Overview

Below is a brief outline of the curriculum areas which we will be focusing upon in class throughout the Autumn term in Class Three.

Please note that the below is a summary and may change over the course of the term based on the children's needs and interests. It does, however, offer insight to enable you to further support your child's learning outside school.

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| English | We will study two texts in Class Three. The first of these is Star of Fear, Star of Hope; the second text is Can We Save the Tiger? Alongside these two texts we shall also be reading Holes and The Boy in the Tower. |
| Maths | Number (up to and including 6-digit numbers) and Place value Addition and Subtraction (including decimals) Multiplication and Division Measurement – Area and Volume Fractions, Decimals and Percentages Shape - Geometry |
| Computing | E-Safety and Digital Literacy PowerPoint |
| R.E. | People of God - How can following God bring freedom and justice? Christmas and the bible (comparing Luke and Matthew) |
| History/ Geography | Geography – The Americas History – Ancient Egypt |
| Science | Let's Get Moving – investigating Gravity, Friction and Floating Living Things and The Circle of Life |
| Music | Children will experience a range of music through singing, listening and engaging with instruments. |
| P.E. | Provided by ASM sports group and Mr Day focusing on invasion games and team skills. |
| Spanish | Introduction to Spanish by Mr Day. |
