There are a number of adaptations that we are making in order to carry out this raffle in the safest possible manner:

- Please enclose the correct payment in the envelope.
- Entries made without an envelope will not be accepted.

- Rather than using raffle tickets, entries will be entered into a spreadsheet (if you have 5 entries, your name will be entered 5 times) and drawn using a random number generator. This will allow us to make the process as contact-free as possible.

The prize winners will be published via the school email and the PTA Facebook page and the prizes will be available for collection from school by Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> December.
