L.O. To make an accurate prediction.

This term we are going to be exploring a new book. For your first lesson, I would like you to make a detailed prediction about what the story could be about by examining the front cover (please see below).

Thursday 7th January

L.O. To write descriptive sentences about a scene.

Look at the first 2 pages of the book, which shows Tom building a snowman in front of a cottage, and in your workbook:

-Make a list of 6 **nouns** which can see (examples-snowdrift, bridge)

-Then, use 2 **adjectives** to describe each noun you have listed (examples-glittery, elegant).

-Rewrite each sentence to include a **noun**, 2 **adjectives** and finally a **preposition** to add detail to your sentence (please see the example below).

Friday 8th January

L.O. To create my own story based upon my prediction.

Today you are going to write your own story based upon your prediction. There are no right or wrong versions of the story, just be creative and have fun.

Please remember to include:

- Cursive handwriting.
- A range of punctuation (. , ! ? " ")
- Adjectives (describing words).
- Expanded noun phrases (1 noun and 2 adjectives).
- Prepositions (where something is or a direction).
- Paragraphs (Beginning, middle and end of your story).
- New characters
