Earlier today, you may have received an email in relation to the 'Arbor' Management Information System which we now use in school. As part of this, we are delighted to be offering the facility for parents/carers to now pay for meals etc online, or through debit/credit card. We know that this is something which has been requested by a number of parents and may be more convenient for some. Payments can still be made by cash at the moment. To access this system, simply follow the login links sent to the registered email address.
