Summer Term Curriculum Update - Reception

Below, you will find a brief outline of the curriculum areas which we will be focusing upon in Reception throughout the Summer term.

<u>Core Subjects</u>	
Literacy	<p>We are continuing our phonetic learning through the scheme Read, Write Inc. We will continue to practise, recap and consolidate set 1 sounds and also continue to learn set 2 sounds. These involve sounds made of digraphs (two letters) and trigraphs (3 letters).</p> <p>We will be reading and discussing a range of fiction and non-fiction books, during whole class reading, guided reading groups and on a one-to-one basis. We will be recalling information from the stories, discussing the characters and setting and using the text to answer inference questions.</p> <p>We will continue to practise segmenting sounds in words for writing. We will be focusing on sentence writing and formation, full stops and finger spaces. As well as our learning of common exception words (red words).</p>
Maths/ Numeracy	<p>This term in Maths, we will be focusing on securing our knowledge of the value of numbers from 1-20. We will continue to practise accurate counting, addition and subtraction of single digits, our knowledge of one more and one less.</p> <p>We will have a particular focus on doubling, halving and number bonds this term. As well as counting in 2s, 10s and 5s.</p> <p>We will explore the properties of 2D and 3D shapes, using our knowledge of measure in practical situations to compare and record results using equipment. We will also explore times to o'clock and half past.</p>

Expressive Arts	<p>This term, we will learn and practise how to draw simple images of people and animals. We will also explore how we can use and change different materials to make pictures and instruments.</p> <p>We will continue our amazing music lessons with our wonderful teacher, Mrs Whitley.</p>
