Class 2 Summer Term 1 Curriculum Overview

I hope you all had a lovely Easter break and that you were able to enjoy some of the sunshine. Whilst this half term is short, it is packed with lots of learning!

Below is a brief outline of the curriculum areas which we will be focusing upon in class throughout the next half term in Class 2.

Please note that the below is a summary and may change over the course of the term based on the children's needs and interests. It does, however, offer insight to enable you to further support your child's learning outside school.

Spanish	In Spanish, Class 2 will be focusing on a unit called 'Desayuno en el café' meaning breakfast at the café where we will look at different café foods and drinks and how to order them.

During the Summer term, Class 2 will have P.E. on a **Thursday** and **Friday**. Please ensure that your child has the appropriate P.E. kit (including footwear) in school on these days, including an outdoor kit.

The children will have the opportunity to visit the mobile library on a Tuesday afternoon where they will be able to borrow a book to read alongside their school reading book.

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Homework this term will consist of spellings practice (which is available on Class Notebook/ OneNote as well as the school website), **daily reading practice** of between 20 and 30 minutes a day and times tables practice through TT Rockstars **at least three times a week. Please note that the Year 4 times tables check will be very similar to the 'soundcheck' format and this should be practiced.**
