These books will be kept in school for EYFS – Years 1 & 2 will be able to take them home and bring them back each day to ensure they don't get lost.

Homework this term will consist of spellings practice for Years 1 and 2 (which is available on the school website), **daily reading practice** of between 10 and 20 minutes a day for Y2, 5 and 10 minutes a day for Y1 and 5 minutes a day for Reception. **Years 1 & 2 will also be asked to practice TT Rockstars 2 – 3 times a week, with stage appropriate tables being set for them.**
