During the Spring 2 term, Class 1 will have P.E. on a **Monday** and **Thursday**. Please ensure that your child has the appropriate P.E. kit (including footwear) in school on these days, including an outdoor kit.

Additionally, Class 1 will take part in forest school sessions on a **Tuesday afternoon**. Children are welcome to bring in clothes that they don't mind getting muddy that can be worn underneath the coats and trousers provided by school.

Homework this term will consist of spellings practice for Years 1 and 2 (which is available on the school website), **daily reading practice** of between 10 and 20 minutes a day for Y2, 5 and 10 minutes a day for Y1 and 5 minutes a day for Reception. **Read Write Inc** books will also be sent home on a Friday for children in years 1 and 2. These will be fully decodable and children will need to practice these to build up fluency. **These books will need to be returned to school by the following Wednesday at the latest.**

Years 1 & 2 will also be asked to practice TT Rockstars 2 – 3 times a week, with stage appropriate tables being set for them.
