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Orange Class

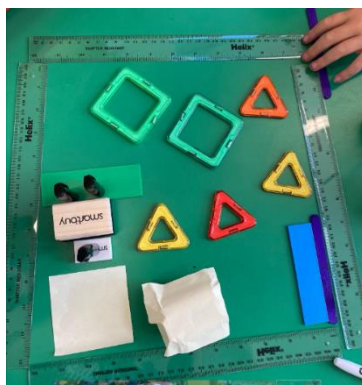
A fantastic start to the term in Orange Class!

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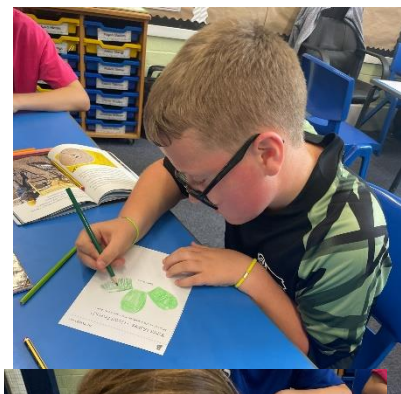
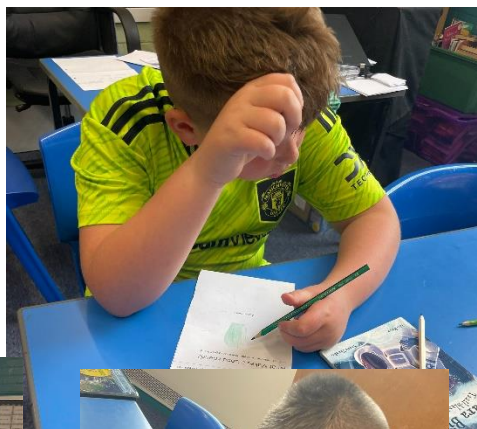
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Violet Class
