Overview of objectives: Writing – Year 1/2

Use plural noun suffixes -s and -es

Ad -er and -est to adjectives

Add -ly to turn adjectives into adverbs

Add suffixes to verbs where no change is needed to the root

Form nouns and adjectives using suffixes

Change the meaning of verbs and adjectives by adding the prefix un-

Combine words to make sentences

Write sentences with different forms: statement, questions, exclamation, command

Leave spaces between words

Join words and clauses using and

Use sub-ordination (using when, if, that or because)

Use co-ordination (using or, and so, but)

Punctuate sentences using a capital letter and a full stop, question mark or exclamation mark Use punctuation correctly: full stops, capital letters, exclamation marks, question marks

Use a capital letter for names of people, places, the days of the week and the personal pronoun *I*

Use punctuation correctly: commas for lists

Use punctuation correctly: apostrophes for contracted forms

Use punctuation correctly: apostrophes for the possessive (singular)

Use simple description

Use expanded noun phrases to describe and specify

Use present and past tenses correctly and consistently

Use the progressive form of verbs in the present and past tense

Spell words containing phonemes already taught

Spell common exception words

Make phonically plausible attempts to spell words that have not yet been learnt

Use homophones and near homophones

Say out loud what is going to be written about Plan or say aloud what is going to be written about Write down ideas, key words, new vocabulary

Compose a sentence orally before writing it

Encapsulate what is to be written, sentence by sentence

Write for different purposes

Sequence sentences to form short narratives

Write narratives about personal experiences and those of others (real or fictional) Write about real events

Write poetry

Re-read what they have written to check that it makes sense

Re-read to check that their writing makes sense and that verbs to indicate time are used correctly and consistently

Proof-read to check for errors in spelling, grammar and punctuation

Discuss what has been written with the teacher or other pupils

Evaluate writing with the teacher and other pupils

Read aloud their writing clearly enough to be heard by their peers and the teacher **Read aloud with intonation**

Make simple additions, revisions and corrections

Overview of objectives: Reading – Year 1/2

Listen to and discuss a wide range of poems, stories and non-fiction at a level beyond that at which can be read independently

Listen to, discuss and express views about a wide range of contemporary and classic poetry, stories and non-fiction at a level beyond that at which can be read independently

Link what is read or heard to own experiences

Discuss the sequence of events in books and how items of information are related

Become familiar with key stories, fairy tales and traditional tales

Become familiar with and retell a wider range of traditional tales

Retell stories and consider their particular characteristics

Recognise and join in with predictable phrases

Recognise simple recurring literary language

Learn to appreciate rhymes and poems

Recite some rhymes and poems by heart

Continue to build up a repertoire of poems learnt by heart

Discuss word meanings, linking new meanings to those already known

Discuss and clarify the meanings of words

Understand both the books that can be read accurately and fluently and those listened to Understand books read independently and those which are listened to

Draw on what they already know

Draw on what is already known or on background information and vocabulary provided by the teacher

Check that the text makes sense

Discuss the significance of the title and events

Make inferences on the basis of what is being said and done
