| <p>Key Vocabulary:</p> | <p>Adult: A fully grown animal or plant. Develop – To grow bigger and become stronger. Life Cycle – The changes living things go through to become an adult. Offspring – The child of an animal. Young – Offspring that has not reached adulthood. Live Young – Offspring that has not hatched from an egg.</p> |
