Why Does Easter Matter to Christians?

<p>EYFS Objectives:</p>	<p><u>PSE – BR:</u> Notice and ask questions about differences, such as skin colour, types of hair, gender, special needs and disabilities and so on;</p> <p><u>CL – LAaU:</u> Understand simple questions about 'who' and 'what'; Understand simple 'what', 'how', 'who', 'where' and 'why' questions;</p> <p><u>UTW – PCaC:</u> Continue developing positive attitudes about the differences between people; Name and describe people who are familiar to them; Begin to know that there are different countries in the world and talk about the differences they have experienced or seen in photos; Talk about members of their immediate family and community; Recognise some environments that are different to the one in which they live; Recognise that people have different beliefs and celebrate special times in different ways.</p>
<p>KS1 Objectives:</p>	<p>To place Salvation in the 'Big Story' of the bible. To re-call events of Holy Week To investigate how Christians show their belief about Jesus being the saviour. To reflect on ideas found within the Easter Story. To recognise Christians believe Jesus builds a bridge between God and humans.</p>
