Re: Class Three Spring Term 2 Curriculum Overview

Below is a brief outline of the curriculum areas which we will be focusing upon in class throughout the second part of the Spring Term in Class Three.

Please note that the below is a summary and may change over the course of the term based on the children's needs and interests. It does, however, offer insight to enable you to further support your child's learning outside school.

English	Writing – The Tin Forest by Helen Ward Guided Reading – A variety of texts using the Reading Explorers Class Text for reading for pleasure – War Horse by Michael Morpurgo
Maths	Number (up to and including 6-digit numbers) and Place Value Addition and Subtraction (including decimals) Multiplication and Division Measurement – Area and Volume Fractions, Decimals and Percentages Shape - Geometry

R.E.	What difference does the resurrection make for Christians?
Geography	Rivers
Science	Living Things & Their Habitats
Music	Instrument Tuition (recorder) with Mrs Whiteley
Art	Ancient Egypt
P.E.	Alternative sports & Rugby with ASM Sports
Spanish	En el colegio (At School) with Mr Day

During the Spring term, Class Three will have P.E. on a **Thursday** and **Friday**. **Please ensure that your child comes to school in their P.E. kit (including footwear) on these days.**

Homework will be sent home on Wednesday and be due in on the following Wednesday. Weekly homework will consist of ten spellings (found on the school website on the Class Three page) and a Maths activity (no more than thirty minutes). It is also the expectation in Upper Key Stage 2 that your child is reading for twenty minutes per night. If this can be documented in your child's home learning diary, either by yourself or your



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child, that would be greatly appreciated. Your child also has access to TTRockstars to help boost their timetable recall knowledge.
