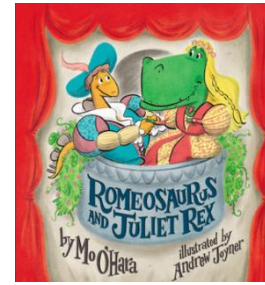
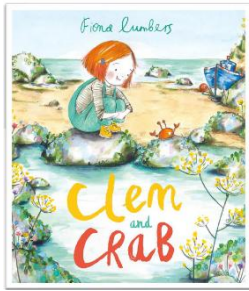


Class One Summer Term 2 Overview.
