Below is a brief outline of the curriculum areas which we will be focusing upon in class throughout the second part of the Summer Term in Class Three.

Please note that the below is a summary and may change over the course of the term based on the children's needs and interests. It does, however, offer insight to enable you to further support your child's learning outside school.

During the Summer Term, Class Three will have P.E. on a **Thursday** and **Friday**. **Please ensure that your child** comes to school in their P.E. kit (including footwear) on these days.

Class Three will also take part in Forest School sessions each Wednesday morning during the Summer Term (sessions begin Wednesday 11th June).
