Literacy	Read a story and draw your favourite character.	Practice writing your name using different colours.	Listen to a story and retell it to a family member.
Numeracy	Count objects around your home (1–10).	Sort toys by size or colour.	Practice writing numbers to 10.
Creative Arts	Make an autumn collage with leaves.	Paint a picture of your family.	Create a puppet using paper or socks – bring it in for our 'Show and Tell' session on a Friday.
Physical Development	Go on a nature walk and collect leaves.	Practice hopping, skipping and jumping.	Build a simple obstacle course at home.
Understanding the World	Talk about the weather and seasons. What clothes do we need to wear in autumn?	Explore different fruits and vegetables - can you print with paint and make patterns?	Learn about animals that hibernate. Can you draw an animal and mark make to label it?
Personal/Social/Emotional	Help tidy up a room at home.	Talk about feelings using drawings.	Share a toy or game with someone.
