Write a thank-you letter to a farmer.	Create a spooky story with a beginning, middle and end.	Write instructions for how to stay safe on Bonfire Night.
Count and sort autumn leaves by size or colour.	Solve a Halloween-themed word problem (e.g. how many pumpkins?).	Practice skip counting using fireworks as visuals. (Counting in 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s).
Draw and label a harvest basket with fruits and vegetables.	Design a Halloween costume and describe it in writing.	Create a firework poem using onomatopoeia (using words that sound the same as the word – bang, pop, fizz, whizz).
Make a list of foods harvested in autumn.	Write a list of Halloween safety rules.	Draw a Bonfire Night scene and write a caption.
Create a harvest-themed word search.	Use tally marks to count Halloween decorations at home or in your local area.	Estimate how many fireworks you might see and record the number.
Retell a story about harvest time.	Make a Halloween card and write a message inside.	Write a short news report about a Bonfire Night event.
