Reading books will be changed fortnightly to ensure there is fluency and a good comprehension of the text.

Each week, we will be focusing on the red and green words that children encounter during their guided reading sessions. This approach allows children to practise and apply their taught phonics and spelling skills in a meaningful, context-based way.

Our 'Show and Tell' session will be each Friday afternoon. May we ask that anything sent in is purposeful and the children have an idea about what they would like to share about their special things in front of their friends.
