Willow Class

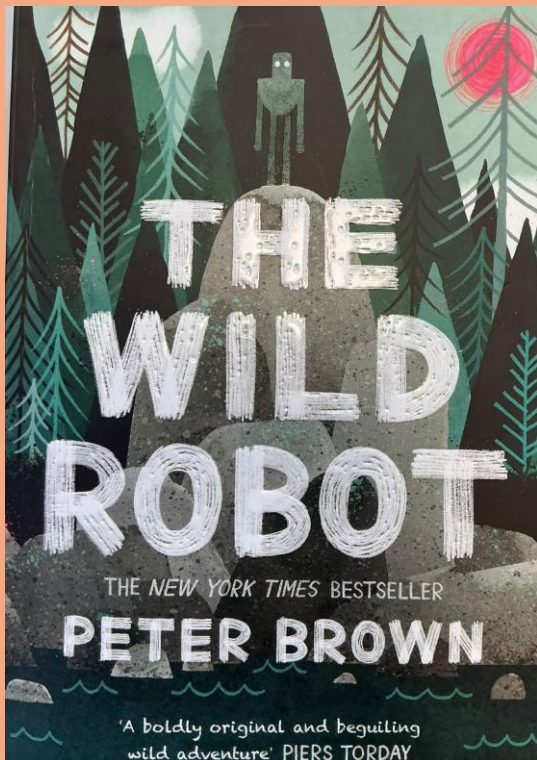
