Create your own spiral pattern using different materials, such as pebbles and autumn leaves.	Draw and label a picture that shows all the people who are special to you. Write a sentence about them.	Learn to do something new such as ride your bike or learn a new song.	Make your own reading den using cushions and blankets. Read your favourite stories in it.
Share a bedtime story. Tell your grown up what happens in the beginning, middle and the end of the story.	Find different leaves and describe what they are like using adjectives.	Take 5 photographs that show signs of autumn. Write a sentence about them.	Find conkers, leaves and pebbles and sort them by their size, shape and colour.
Practise your throwing and catching skills at home with your family or friends. Can you count how many times you have thrown and caught?	Bake a festive treat with a grown up. Can you write how you made it and take a photograph of the finished product?	Create an animal using only natural materials you find outside, such as leaves, sticks, acorns or pine cones.	Keep a weather diary for a week. Can you draw what the weather was like each day?

Complete 5 acts of kindness. We will share some of those in class.	Help collect food for a food bank or create a poster explaining why sharing is important.	Create a Christmas decoration to hang up at home.	Learn some harvest songs and perform them to your friends and family.
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
